Dear Sir,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your son, the late No. 1339, Sergeant E. G. Summons, 3rd Army Field Artillery Brigade, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that, on 30th September, 1918, he was in a shell hole which was being used as a protection against shell fire. At the time, the Battery was under severe hostile fire, a direct hit being made in the shell hole, wounding the late soldier severely in the face. He was carried to a British Casualty Clearing Station in Ronsoy, where he died an hour afterwards. The location of his grave has not yet been advised, but it is confidently hoped that, through the efforts of the Graves Registration and Enquiries Committee, a burial report will be received later and any further particulars contained therein will be promptly communicated to you.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.
