The late No.1564 Corporal R.W. Lewis, 3rd Pioneer Battalion, is stated to have enlisted under an assumed name, his correct one being R.W. Carr.

Upon enlistment he nominated Mr. John Lewis (father) of Laidley, Queensland, as next-of-kin, but it has since been established that there is no such person, the proper next-of-kin being deceased's mother, Mrs. C. Carr, of Woolloowin, Queensland - the father is deceased.

My file discloses that the deceased soldier left behind him an ex-nuptial daughter on whose behalf a pension is being paid by the Government, the War Gratuity has been handed over in trust for this child.

The child's custodian - her maternal aunt - desires deceased's war medals, etc., on behalf of his daughter, while the late soldier's mother strongly protests and in her communication states :-

"I wish to protest again at the action you are taking re medals, same as I did with the War Gratuity, as the child was never his, if you want to know who it does belong to it was the boss the mother was working for at the time, so trusting you will look into the matter before you place those medals, etc., in trust."

I have no doubt the War Gratuity Board fully investigated the statements made above and, as they have seen fit to halve the War Gratuity, it is recommended that the usual practice in cases of this description be followed, viz.,

- (a) Victory Medal and Memorial Scroll to Miss M.A. Francis, Laidley, Queensland, in trust for deceased's ex-nuptial daughter,
- (b) British War Medal, Memorial Plaque, and Brochure "Where the Australians Rest" to the late soldier's mother.

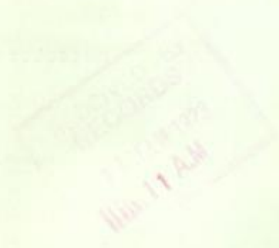
