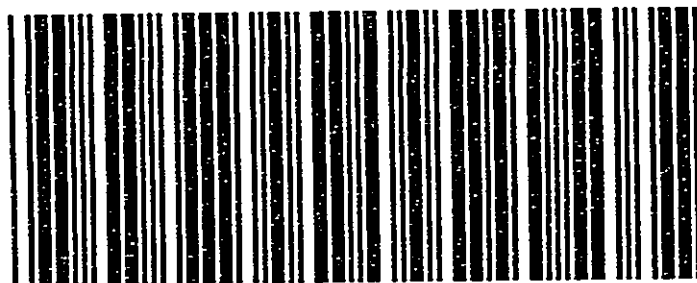

He was reported missing some time last summer. I made a shield with his name and particulars to be fastened on to the cross over his grave. I did not see the grave. I made the shield at the Transport H.Q. at Longueval in February this year, after his grave had been found, and had previously only been marked by a small cross. I heard that the grave was two or three miles away, but did not see it.
