Dear Madam,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your son, the late No. 3427 Sergeant L.M. Paternoster, 11th Field Artillery Brigade, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he was admitted to hospital on 24/4/18 suffering from gunshot wounds right shoulder, left knee, right side, right ankle, received in action. The head of the fibula was fractured, and several foreign bodies were extracted at an operation which was performed on same date. He died on 26/4/18, and was buried the following day in Bagneaux Military Cemetery, Gagnaincourt, grave No. 13, plot 1, row "D", the Rev. C.F. Newell officiating.

The utmost care and attention is being devoted where possible to the graves of our soldiers. It is understood photographs of graves are being taken as soon as is possible and these will be transmitted to next-of-kin when available.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connexion with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.

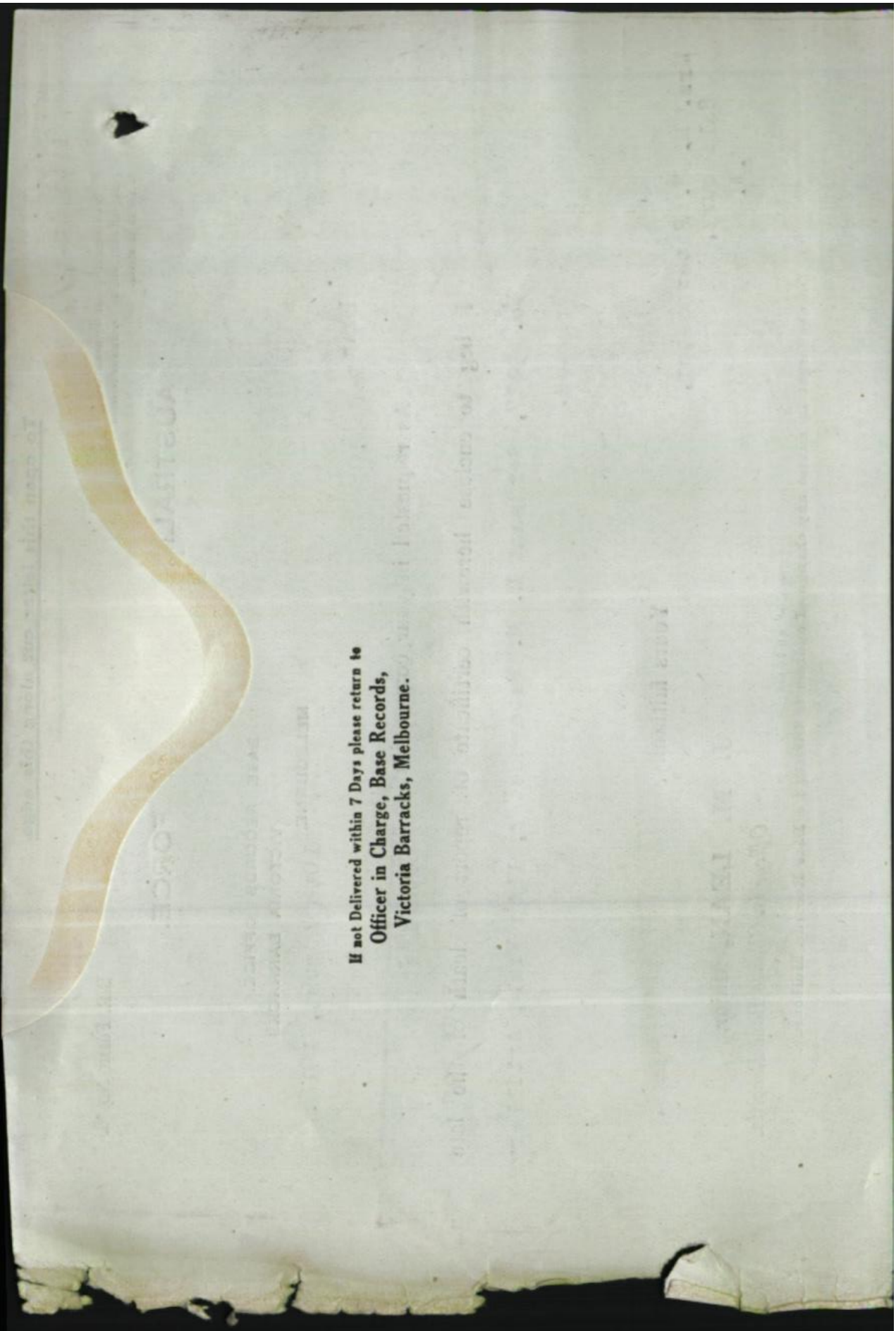
