Israel, 20th Battalion, in the Crucifix Corner British Cemetery, Villers Bretonneux.

According to the latest progress report received from the overseas authorities the final constructional work and the erection of headstones in this cemetery is now almost completed, but it is not the intention of the Government to supply next-of-kin with photographs of the completed war graves.
